- 3. "Elementary" refers to grades Pre/K-8
- 4. "Secondary" refers to grades 9-12.
- 5. The different art forms referenced in this survey with the exception of Media Arts are taken from the Visual and Performing Arts Content Standards for California Public Schools (<u>http://www.cde.ca.gov/be/st/ss/documents/vpastandards.pdf</u>). Media Arts here includes screenbased projects presented via film, television, radio, audio, video, the Internet, interactive and mobile technologies, video games, transmedia storytelling, and satellite as well as media-related printed books, catalogues, and journals.
