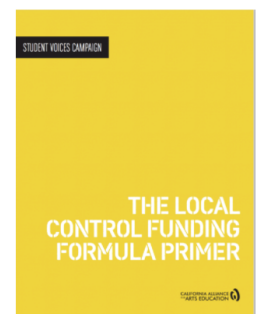
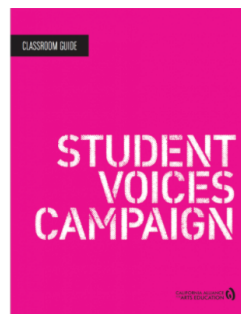


CLASSROOM GUIDE FOR STUDENT VOICES ADVOCACY PROJECT
